

Well done to Year 6 (again!) and Year 1, joint winners of the punctuality award, with no lates! It's been another good week with only 16 lates, down from a recent high of 26 last week. This week there are a couple of children who were late more than once. If you are struggling in the morning please do reach out to us for advice and help to support you and ensure your child isn't missing out on the key information at the start of the day and also feeling self-conscious by arriving late when all their friends are already started and know what is going on.

This term has, overall, seen a huge improvement from the same period last year and for that we thank you all.

Remember, classrooms are open from 8.45am so children (and adults) do not need to wait in the cold or rain outside. The QUBE in the junior playground is also open from 8am for breakfast club. Lets get everyone here on time everyday so no child misses their own learning or disturbs/delays the learning of others. Thank you for your continued support.

After two fantastic weeks, unfortunately this week's attendance is significantly down and pulled down overall attendance for the term to 95.6% - edging away from that 96% target. Well done to Y5 and Y4 - both above 96% again and to Y3 who came very close. Next week is the half term and hopefully a week to recharge the batteries will enable all the children, especially those in the classes worst hit by absence this week, to come back with renewed vigour and able to move forward maximising their time learning. Year 6, Year 5 and Year 3 are all currently above 96% for the term, while Year 4 and Year 1 are above 95%. Year 2 and Reception are bother low. Thank you for the hard work this term in helping us make the progress we have and supporting your children in getting to school regularly. Let's look ahead to the second half of the term and see if we can build on this moving forward and continue to improve overall attendance. Well done to all your children for their resilience and dedication to their learning.
