After last week where this was not the case it is excellent to see a huge improvement this week (although Y2 and Y4 still too many children coming in late and often more than once in the week. Compared to last weeks high of 61 this week we had 24. If your child was one of those arriving late this week, please ensure that you support them to leave with plenty of time to get here. Classrooms are open from 8.45am so children (and adults) do not need to wait in the cold or rain outside. The QUBE in the junior playground is also open from 8am for breakfast club. Lets get everyone here on time everyday so no child misses their own learning or disturbs/delays the learning of others.

## Weekly Attendance Award

This week, Year 6 are top (again!) with just under 100% attendance, well done! Year 1 just behind them this week in second place with Year 5 third and also above 98%. Year 3, for the second week running, came in a fraction below our target level of 96%. There is room for improvement from Year 4, Year 2 and Reception. Overall for this week attendance is 94.5% - dipping below the whole school target of 96%. For the year so far we are currently at 95.2% so not too far from the 96% target. Improved attendance in Reception and Year 4 will help pull us up. All the other classes are currently above 95% for the year with Years 5 and 6 out front, above 97% for the year so far. Whilst we understand that it is the season for coughs and colds and other bugs, we need to encourage resilience and often we find that children are able to manage and get through the day with the distraction of being in school. It's particularly important for the youngest children to build good attendance habits right from the start of their school life. Thank you for your continued support.

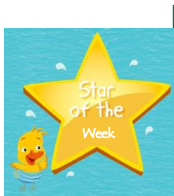
For your super effort and behaviour on our trip to Chinatown! You were so engaged with spotting all the cool sights and you did some lovely drawings. Well done you!
