Weekly Attendance Award

This week, Year 6 are top (again!) with just under 100% attendance, well done! Year 1 just behind them this week in second place with Year 5 third and also above 98%. Year 3, for the second week running, cam in a fraction below our target level of 96%. There is room for improvement from Year 4, Year 2 and Reception. Overall for this week attend ance is 94.5% - dipping below the whole school target of 96%. For the year so far we are currently at 95.2% so not too far from the 96% target. Improved attendance in Reception and Year 4 will help pull us up. All the other classes are currently




























Year 3 & Year 4 Dodgebal
